Expectations

Classroom Routines and Procedures

Be Prepared for School

- Get a good night's sleep
- Eat a good breakfast
- Come to school on time
- Bring a healthy snack
- Only water allowed in classroom
- Bring homework, supplies and your planner to class
- Be prepared for recess by dressing appropriately for recess

Beginning of the day

- Greet your teacher each morning with "hello or good morning"
- Put away your backpack & get all your supplies that you will need
- Turn in any homework to the try on the counter
- Make sure you have two (2) sharpened pencils
- Make sure your water bottle is filled
- Finish your classroom assignment (if you have one)
- Bell rings at 7:40, if you are not in the classroom you are tardy, you will need to get a tardy slip

During class time

- You may use the bathroom any time except during direct instruction or during group collaboration (emergencies excluded)
- You will need to sign out when you go to the restroom and sign back in when you return (remember to wash your hands)
- Fill your water bottle at the beginning of the day or at lunch
- If you do not have a water bottle, follow the same procedure as going to the restroom
- Stay on task, actively participate, problem solve through respectful communication and compromise, stay with your group or partner
- Independent work is done at your desk unless otherwise directed
- Snack time is after "specials"
- Talking at an acceptable volume is fine but there are times when silence (no talking) is necessary, I will help you with this

Assignment

- All assignments need to have your name (first) and number on them, they should be on the line not in the air
- You should date your work and entries in your journals
- If you do not complete an assignment within the specified time you will need to go to study hall which is during recess unless otherwise directed
- If you are absent, it is your responsibility to ask the teacher for assignments you may have missed
- You will have the same amount of time to complete assignments that you were absent, make sure you write absent at the top of the assignment
- If you are unclear about an assignment "ask 3 than me" unless it is a test/quiz, then raise your hand
- If you finish an assignment early see poster for things to do

Classroom Library (Ms. Winfrey's Room)

- Treat all books with respect
- You may read anytime you have finished all other work **
- Stay at your desk to read unless otherwise directed
- You must check out books from the class library using the sign-out procedure (Ms. Winfrey will explain)
- Keep the classroom library neat and orderly, returning books to the proper place, follow directions given by class librarian
- Books are not to be removed from the classroom until approved

Computers (classroom 1 to 1 ipads, desktops, laptops, personal devices

- Only one person per device unless otherwise directed
- Headphones or earbuds must be used when using sound
- You must have approval before you print anything
- Know how to use your flash drive and use it to save all work
- Use your device responsibly; games, texting anyone, air dropping or surfing the net is not allowed unless otherwise directed
- Before you can bring your own device, I need to have a completed form on file
- Read and review the 1 to 1 ipad student agreement/handbook, sign and turn in the last page

Hallways

- Stay in line, number order one behind the other, 5th graders are bigger and take up more room, we do not walk side by side
- Walk on the right hand side of the hallway unless otherwise directed
- We are quiet in the hallways, no talking, it only takes about 90 seconds to get where ever we are going, you can be quiet for that amount of time
- Stay together, no big gaps in the line as we walk through the halls

End of the Day

- Make sure your assignments, notes or project due dates are recorded in your planner
- Put your homework, needed materials and other mail to be taken home in your backpack
- Do your classroom job
- Line up quietly, in number order and wait to leave
- Stay together, no big gaps in line
- When we get outside everyone says good-bye and gives a fist bump

Fire Drills, Tornado Drills, Lock Down:

- Fire Drill
 *Line up quickly and silently at the door
 *Follow Fire Drill procedures
 *No talking in the halls or outside
 *Once we are back in class let's get back to work

 Tornado Drill
 *Line up quickly and silently at the door
 *Follow Tornado Drill procedures
 *No talking/listening for instructions
 *Once we are back in class let's get back to work
- Lock Down Drill
 - *Move quickly and silently to designated area in the classroom *Follow Lockdown Drill procedures
 - *Absolute Silence; our safety depends on this
 - *Once we are back in class let's get back to work

Problem Solving

- Problem at Recess

 Try to solve the problem calmly using Conflict Resolution
 *Move away from the situation
 *Ask a recess duty teacher for help, if necessary
- Problem with Friends
 *Look for a Win/Win
 *Seek to understand than to be understood
 *Apologize
 *Take a break from your friend
 *Be polite
 *Ask an adult for help
 * Ask to see the counselor

 Problems with Grades
 *Ask for help-parents, friends, teachers
 *Talk to your teacher about your grade
 *Make a plan as to how you can improve your grades
 - *Follow your plan, if it is not working, adjust your plan
